Photography and videography are prohibited. Do not record on campus without permission.



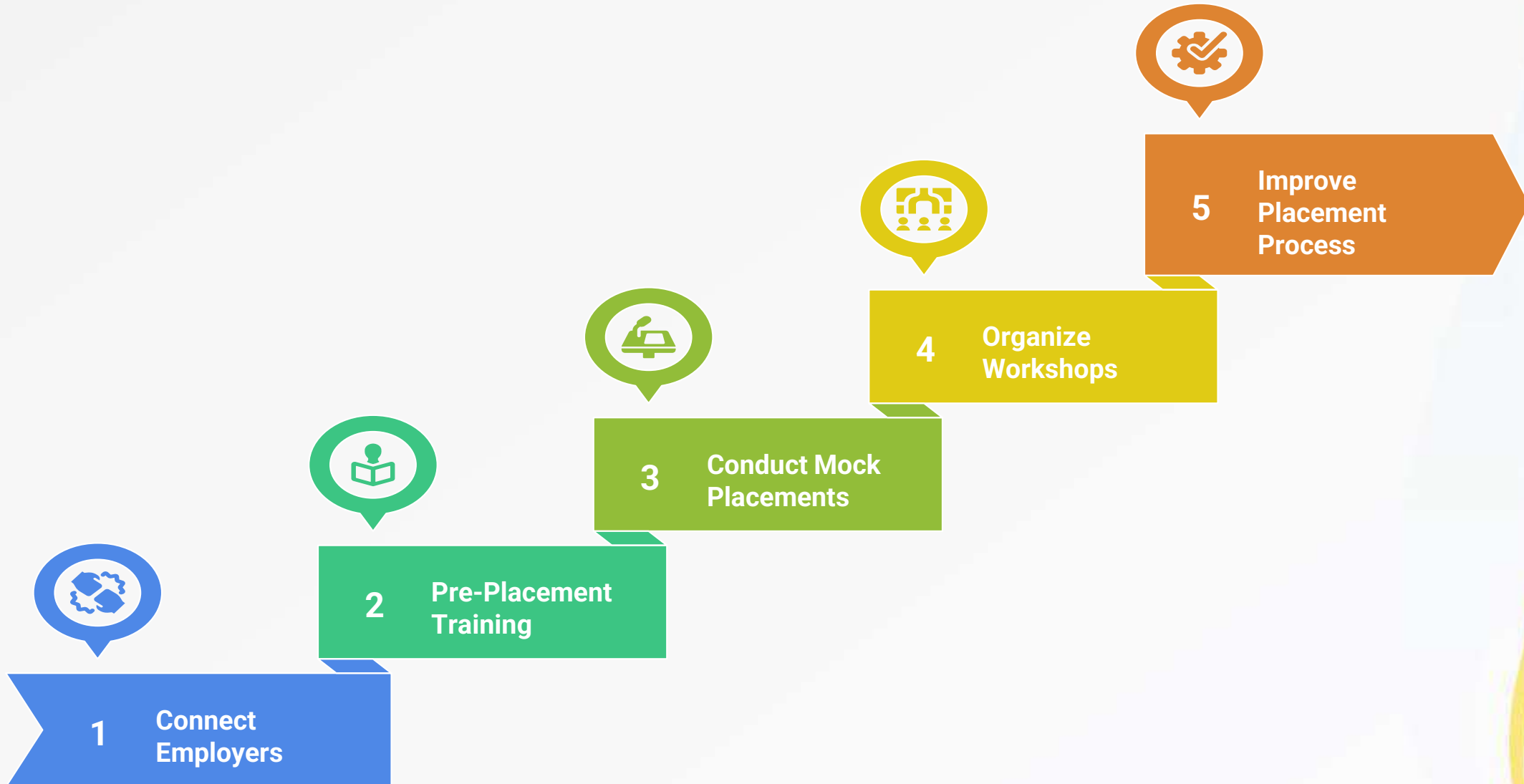
